### EVERGREENS

#### BALSAM FIR

*Abies balsamea*

Zone: 3 Height: 20 m

Spread: 8 m

Shape: Pyramidal

Foliage: Bright green

Fruit: Cone (SUN)

Slow growing, symmetrical evergreen with soft fragrant needles. A popular variety of Christmas tree.

#### DWARF BALSAM FIR

*Abies balsamea 'Nana'*

Zone: 5 Height: 60 cm

Spread: 100 cm

Shape: Low, spreading

Foliage: Dark green

Fruit: Cone (SUN)

Dwarf, globular shrub with dense branches. Tolerant of shade or sun, looser growing in shade.

#### WHITE FIR

*Abies concolor*

Zone: 3 Height: 18 m

Spread: 4.5 m

Shape: Pyramidal

Foliage: Bluish Green

Fruit: Cone (SUN)

An excellent specimen conifer, with a medium growth rate.

#### FRASER FIR

*Abies fraseri*

Zone: 5 Height: 20 m

Spread: 6m

Shape: Pyramidal

Foliage: Dark green

Fruit: Cone (SUN)

A specimen evergreen with glossy dark green foliage.

#### ROCKY MOUNTAIN FIR

*Abies lasiocarpa 'Compacta'*

Zone: 5 Height: 2.5 m

Spread: 1 m

Shape: Conical

Foliage: Silvery blue

Fruit: Cone (SUN)

A dwarf variety that is slow growing and very compact. Excellent for a rock garden specimen.

#### DOUGLAS FIR

*Pseudotsuga menziesii*

Zone: 4 Height: 20 m

Spread: 5 m

Shape: Pyramidal

Foliage: Green

Fruit: Cone (SUN)

Not unlike the Colorado Spruce, but with softer foliage. Ideal tree for windbreaks and screening.

#### WEeping NOOKTA FALSE CYPRESS

*Chamaecyparis nootkatensis*

'Pendula'

Zone: 5 Height: 6 m

Spread: 4 m

Shape: Pyramidal

Foliage: Dark green

Fruit: Cone (SUN, PS)

Very unusual with its pendulous branches and upright habit. An excellent specimen tree. Slow to medium growth

#### DWARF HINOKI

#### FALSE CYPRESS

*Chamaecyparis obtusa 'Nana Gracilis'*

Zone: 5 Height: 1 m

Spread: 1 m

Shape: Irregular, Compact

Foliage: Dark green

(SUN, PS)

A dwarf specimen plant with rich, broadly upright, fan-shaped sprays.

#### THREADLEAF FALSE CYPRESS

*Chamaecyparis pisifera*

'Filifera'

Zone: 5 Height: 4 m

Spread: 4 m

Shape: Pyramidal

Foliage: Green (SUN, PS)

This plant creates a graceful mound of medium green thread like foliage. Very hardy.

#### GOLDEN THREADLEAF FALSE CYPRESS

*Chamaecyparis pisifera*

'Filifera Aurea'

Zone: 5 Height: 3 m

Spread: 2 m

Shape: Mounding

Foliage: Golden-yellow

(SUN, PS)

A slow growing mound or squat pyramid with golden, thread-like foliage all year.

#### MOPS CYPRESS

*Chamaecyparis pisifera*

'Mops'

Zone: 4 Height: 1 m

Spread: 2 m

Shape: Mounding (SUN)

A low mounding form with brilliant gold, thread-like foliage. Needs full sun for best colour.

#### SIBERIAN CARPET CYPRESS

*Microbiota decussata*

Zone: 3 Height: 30 cm

Spread: 1.5 m

Shape: Prostrate

Foliage: Green

(SUN or SHADE)

Juniper-like flat spreader. Good fast growing ground cover with green foliage turning bronze in winter.

### JUNIPER (spreading)

#### GOLD STAR JUNIPER

*Juniperus chinensis*

'Bakaurea'

Zone: 3 Height: 1.25 m

Spread: 1.75 m

Shape: Compact

Foliage: Golden (SUN)

A semi-dwarf variety with dense growth. Distinctive golden colour with bright tips. Excellent for foundation or mass plantings.

#### MINT JULEP JUNIPER

*Juniperus x media 'Mint*

*Julep'*

Zone: 4 Height: 1.5 m

Spread: 1.5 m (SUN)

Shape: Horizontal, spreading

Foliage: Brilliant mint green

Has a compact habit with appealing arching branches.

#### PAUL'S GOLD JUNIPER

*Juniperus chinensis 'Paul's Gold'*

Zone: 3 Height: 50 cm

Spread: 60 cm (SUN)

Shape: Horizontal, spreading

Foliage: Extremely golden

Intense golden colour characterizes this slow growing juniper.

#### SAN JOSE JUNIPER

*Juniperus chinensis 'San*

*Jose'*

Zone: 2 Height: 60 cm

Spread: 2m

Shape: Horizontal,

Foliage: Blue-green (SUN)

A dense prostrate shrub with attractive blue foliage.

## **LIMEGLOW JUNIPER**

*Juniperus chinensis*  
'Limeglow'  
Zone: 4 Height: 50 cm  
Spread: 1.5 m  
Shape: Low, spreading  
Foliage: Bright green  
(SUN)

A ground-hugging evergreen that's great in mass plantings or as a bedding plant.

## **BLUE CHIP JUNIPER**

*Juniperus horizontalis*  
'Blue Chip'  
Zone: 3 Height: 20 cm  
Spread: 1.2 m  
Shape: Mounding (SUN)  
Foliage: Silvery blue

Superb colour and fine foliage. Spreading habit creates a superior ground cover.

## **BAR HARBOR JUNIPER**

*Juniperus horizontalis*  
'Glauca'  
Zone: 2 Height: 15 cm  
Spread: 1 m  
Shape: Prostrate  
Foliage: Blue (SUN)

Tightly matted stems that hug the ground. Summer foliage is soft blue-green, turning to silvery-plum in the winter.

## **ICEE BLUE JUNIPER**

*Juniperus horizontalis*  
'Icee Blue'  
Zone: 3 Height: 10cm  
Spread: 2m  
Shape: low, compact  
Foliage: Silvery-blue (SUN)

Dense, tightly compressed foliage with a purple tinge resembles a thick carpet.

## **COMPACT ANDORRA JUNIPER**

*Juniperus horizontalis*  
'Plumosa Compacta'  
Zone: 2 Height: 50 cm  
Spread: 1.5 cm  
Shape: Horizontal, spreading  
Foliage: Light green (SUN)

A lovely juniper, rich in colour. Purplish in the fall.

## **BLUE RUG JUNIPER**

*Juniperus horizontalis*  
'Wiltonii'  
Zone: 2 Height: 15 cm  
Spread: 1 m  
Shape: Horizontal, spreading  
Foliage: Silvery-blue (SUN)

Outstanding colour makes this an ideal selection for ground cover or rock garden plantings.

## **JAPANESE GARDEN JUNIPER**

*Juniperus procumbens*  
'Nana'  
Zone: 2 Height: 20 cm  
Spread: 1 m (SUN)  
Shape: Creeping  
Foliage: Bluish-green

A ground hugging spreader with delightful cushion form and beautiful bluish-green foliage.

## **CALGARY CARPET JUNIPER**

*Juniperus sabina* 'Calgary Carpet'  
Zone: 3 Height: 25 cm  
Spread: 1.2 m  
Shape: Low, spreading  
Foliage: Green (SUN)

Displays a low spreading habit with overlapping branches. Attractive soft green foliage.

## **TAMARIX JUNIPER**

*Juniperus sabina*  
'Tamariscifolia'  
Zone: 2 Height: 30 cm  
Spread: 1 m  
Shape: Prostrate  
Foliage: Dark Green (SUN)

Feathery green foliage and prostrate spreading form make this an excellent and attractive variety.

## **GREY OWL JUNIPER**

*Juniperus scopulorum*  
'Grey Owl'  
Zone: 3 Height: 1 m  
Spread: 2 m  
Shape: Rounded, Spreading  
Fruit: Blue berry  
Foliage: Silver-gray (SUN)

A strong growing juniper with finely textured foliage.

## **BLUE STAR JUNIPER**

*Juniperus squamata* 'Blue Star'  
Zone: 5 Height: 40 cm  
Spread: 1 m  
Shape: Mounded (SUN)  
Foliage: Bright steel-blue

Standout dense bush. Ideal for rock gardens.

## **JUNIPER (upright)**

### **FAIRVIEW JUNIPER**

*Juniperus chinensis*  
'Fairview'  
Zone: 5 Height: 3 m  
Spread: 1 m  
Shape: Pyramidal, upright  
Foliage: Green (SUN)

A juniper of strong form that is able to withstand exposed conditions.

### **MOUNTBATTEN JUNIPER**

*Juniperus chinensis*  
'Mountbatten'  
Zone: 4 Height: 4 m  
Spread: 2 m  
Shape: Pyramidal  
Fruit: Blue berry  
Foliage: Silvery-green  
Fall Colour: Purplish (SUN)

A hardy, rapid growing, compact-columnar form.

### **GNOM JUNIPER**

*Juniperus communis* 'Gnom'  
Zone: 3 Height: 4 m  
Spread: 1.5 m  
Shape: Upright, columnar  
Foliage: Grey-green (SUN)

Standout juniper with a bluish cast, and tight growth habit. Extremely hardy.

### **MOFFET JUNIPER**

*Juniperus scopulorum*  
'Moffetii'  
Zone: 4 Height: 4 m  
Spread: 1.2 m  
Shape: Pyramidal, narrow  
Fruit: Blue berry  
Foliage: Silvery-blue (SUN)

Symmetrical juniper of intense colour.

## **WICHITA BLUE JUNIPER**

*Juniperus scopulorum*  
'Wichita Blue'  
Zone: 4 Height: 4 m  
Spread: 1.2 m  
Shape: Pyramidal  
Foliage: Bright blue (SUN)

An attractive pyramidal evergreen with a broad full upright habit and foliage that stays bright all year.

## **BLUE ARROW JUNIPER**

*Juniperus virginiana* 'Blue Arrow'  
Zone: 4 Height: 4 m  
Spread: 80 cm  
Shape: Pyramidal  
Foliage: Bright blue (SUN)

A narrow selection with bright blue foliage.

## **SKYROCKET JUNIPER**

*Juniperus virginiana*  
'Skyrocket'  
Zone: 3 Height: 4.6 m  
Spread: 80 cm  
Shape: Narrow, pyramidal  
Foliage: Blue-green (SUN)

Great near entrances and places where broader evergreens are out of place. Extremely narrow.

## **LARCH**

### **EUROPEAN LARCH**

*Larix decidua*  
Zone: 2 Height: 15 m  
Spread: 7 m  
Shape: Pyramidal  
Flower: Yellow-green  
Fruit: Cones  
Foliage: Bright green  
Fall Colour: Yellow (SUN)

Rapid growing conifer. Useful for windscreens and solitary plantings. Sheds its needles in late fall.

## WEeping EUROPEAN LARCH

*Larix decidua 'Pendula'*  
Zone: 4  
Shape: Weeping  
Fruit: Cones  
Foliage: Green  
Fall Colour: Golden (SUN)

Soft weeping foliage. If staked will grow to 5 meters in height. Absolutely outstanding when used with large rock and water features.

## AMERICAN LARCH

*Larix laricina*  
Zone: 1 Height: 26 m  
Spread: 10 m  
Shape: Pyramidal  
Fruit: Cones  
Foliage: Blue-green  
Fall Colour: Yellow (SUN)

Open shaped with a slender trunk, horizontal branches and drooping branchlets. Drops its needles in late fall.

## SPRUCE

### NORWAY SPRUCE

*Picea abies*  
Zone: 2 Height: 25 m  
Spread: 10 m  
Shape: Pyramidal  
Flower: Yellow-red  
Fruit: Cones  
Foliage: Dark green (SUN)

Tall, rapid growing tree, great for use as a windbreak.

### ELEGANS DWARF NORWAY SPRUCE

*Picea abies 'Elegans'*  
Zone: 3 Height: 80 cm  
Spread: 1.2 m  
Shape: Low, rounded  
Foliage: Green  
Fruit: Cones (SUN)

A dwarf plant with deep coloured foliage.

### NEST SPRUCE

*Picea abies 'Nidiformis'*  
Zone: 3 Height: 80 cm  
Spread: 1.5 m  
Shape: Flat-topped, mounded  
Flower: Yellow-red  
Fruit: Cones (SUN, PS)  
Foliage: Light green

Interesting, broad, nest-like plant. Very hardy.

## WEeping NORWAY SPRUCE

*Picea abies 'Pendula'*  
Zone: 3  
Shape: Pendulous, weeping  
Flower: Yellow-red  
Fruit: Cones  
Foliage: Light green (SUN)

A distinctive specimen with weeping branches. It will remain prostrate along the ground unless staked up.

## WHITE SPRUCE

**Native**  
*Picea glauca*  
Zone: 2 Height: 25 m  
Spread: 4.5 m  
Shape: Pyramidal  
Fruit: Cones  
Foliage: Green (SUN)

Hardy, shapely tree, used as a specimen or windbreak.

## SERBIAN SPRUCE

*Picea omorika*  
Zone: 5 Height: 21 m  
Spread: 4.5 m  
Shape: Pyramidal  
Foliage: Green (SUN)

A hardy ornamental spruce which is very attractive with its green silvery leaves.

## DWARF SERBIAN SPRUCE

*Picea omorika 'Nana'*  
Zone: 4 Height: 1.5 m  
Spread: 1.5 m  
Shape: Broad, pyramidal  
Foliage: Bluish-green (SUN, PS)

Dwarf plant with blue-white bands on the underside of glossy, blue-green needles. Ideal for rock garden or foundation planting. Slow growing.

## FAT ALBERT BLUE SPRUCE

*Picea pungens 'Fat Albert'*  
Zone: 3 Height: 6 m  
Spread: 2.5 m  
Shape: Broad, conical  
Fruit: Cones  
Foliage: Silvery-blue (SUN)

An outstanding dwarf blue spruce with a naturally straight leader and well shaped form. Slow growing.

## COLORADO BLUE SPRUCE

*Picea pungens 'Glauca'*  
Zone: 2 Height: 20 m  
Spread: 5 m  
Shape: Pyramidal  
Fruit: Cones  
Foliage: Blue (SUN)

A beautiful blue form with rigid, tiered branches that are densely covered and easily sheared. Will tolerate fully exposed conditions.

## NEON BLUE SPRUCE

*Picea pungens 'Neon Blue'*  
Zone: 3 Height: 9 m  
Spread: 5 m  
Shape: Pyramidal  
Foliage: Bright blue (SUN)

A slow-growing, naturally tight plant with a compact and symmetrical shape. Vibrant foliage. Never requires pruning.

## ROYAL KNIGHT BLUE SPRUCE

*Picea pungens 'Glauca Royal Knight'*  
Zone: 3 Height: 12 m  
Spread: 4 m  
Foliage: Silvery-blue  
Shape: Pyramidal (SUN)

This naturally dense Blue Spruce shapes itself. Excellent foliage.

## PYRAMIDAL BLUE SPRUCE

*Picea pungens 'Iseli fastigiata'*  
Zone: 2 Height: 5 m  
Spread: Narrow  
Foliage: Blue (SUN)

Blue spruce with very narrow habit. Bright foliage.

## GLOBE BLUE SPRUCE

*Picea pungens 'Glauca Globosa'*  
Zone: 2 Height: 80 cm  
Spread: 1.5 m  
Shape: Globe  
Fruit: Cones  
Foliage: Silvery-blue (SUN)

Silvery-blue in late spring, turning to green-blue in the summer. Slow growing.

## PINE

### BRISTLEcone PINE

*Pinus aristata*  
Zone: 2 Height: 1 m  
Spread: 1 m  
Shape: Upright, can be pendulous  
Fruit: Cones  
Foliage: Green (SUN)

A dwarf pine native to the American Rockies. Ideal for rock gardens and bonsai. Dark green needles are scattered with white resin droplets that is often mistaken for scale. Slow growing.

### CHALET SWISS STONE PINE

*Pinus cembra 'Chalet'*  
Zone: 2 Height: 10 m  
Spread: 2 m  
Shape: Narrow, columnar  
Fruit: Cones  
Foliage: Blue-Green (SUN, PS)

Wonderful cultivar of the Swiss Stone Pine. Matures to a dense, conical shape. Very hardy. Slow growth rate.

### MUGHO PINE

*Pinus mugo var. pumilio*  
Zone: 1 Height: 1 m  
Spread: 2 m  
Shape: Rounded  
Fruit: Cones  
Foliage: Dark green (SUN, PS)

A compact bush of dwarf globular form much used in foundation and rocky plantings.

### SLOWMOUND PINE

*Pinus mugo 'Slowmound'*  
Zone: 2 Height: 1 m  
Spread: 2 m  
Shape: Rounded  
Foliage: Dark green  
Fruit: Cones (SUN, PS)

A true dwarf Mugo with a dense mounded shape. Suitable for confined areas.

## AUSTRIAN PINE

*Pinus nigra*  
Zone: 4 Height: 16 m  
Spread: 15 m  
Shape: Pyramidal  
Fruit: Cones  
Foliage: Dark green  
(SUN, PS)

A stately vigorous tree with long rich green needles. Withstands city smoke.

## COMPACT AUSTRIAN PINE

*Pinus nigra 'Compacta'*  
Zone: 5 Height: 5 m  
Spread: 3 m  
Shape: Upright, Dense  
Foliage: Green (SUN)

A smaller stature for tight spaces or city gardens. Retains its lush colour well. Tolerant of dry or alkaline soil conditions.

## EASTERN WHITE PINE

*Native*  
*Pinus strobus*  
Zone: 3 Height 18 m  
Spread: 7 m  
Shape: Pyramidal  
Fruit: Cones  
Foliage: Dark green  
(SUN, PS)

The native pine of eastern Canada. Rapid growth forms an open conical shape. Soft green needles.

**PYRAMIDAL WHITE PINE**  
*Pinus sylvestris 'Fastigiata'*  
Zone: 3 Height: 15 m  
Spread: 2.5 m  
Shape: Pyramidal  
Foliage: Blue-green (SUN)

Rapid growing, narrow dense form. Can be clipped for a more formal appearance.

## DWARF WHITE PINE

*Pinus strobus 'Nana'*  
Zone: 3 Height: 1 m  
Spread: 2 m  
Shape: Rounded  
Fruit: Cones  
Foliage: Dark blue-green  
(SUN)

Excellent plant for foundation or entry settings. Slow-growing and shrubby with a bushy, irregularly branched, rounded habit.

## WEeping WHITE PINE

*Pinus strobus 'Pendula'*  
Zone: 4 Height: 2 m  
Spread: 3 m  
Shape: Weeping  
Fruit: Cones  
Foliage: Blue-green (SUN)

A weeping form of pine. Open and irregular structure with long bluish needles.

**SCOTS PINE**  
*Pinus sylvestris*  
Zone: 3 Height: 18 m  
Spread: 15 m  
Shape: Pyramidal  
Fruit: Cones  
Foliage: Blue-green (SUN)

A hardy rapid growing Pine that will adapt itself to almost any location or soil.

**DWARF SCOTS PINE**  
*Pinus sylvestris 'Globoso Viridis'*  
Zone: 3 Height: 2 m  
Spread: 2 m  
Shape: Rounded  
Foliage: Green  
Fruit: Cones (SUN)

A dense dwarf pine with long green twisted needles.

## YEW

### PYRAMIDAL JAPANESE YEW

*Taxus cuspidata*  
Zone: 4 Height: 2.m  
Spread: 1.5 m  
Shape: Pyramidal  
Fruit: Red berry  
Foliage: Dark shiny green  
(SUN or SHADE)

Annual shearing after new growth has formed is advisable to keep in a compact form.

**GLOBE YEW**  
*Taxus cuspidata globosa*  
Zone: 4 Height: 1.5 m  
Spread: 1.5 m  
Shape: Rounded  
Foliage: Deep green  
(SUN or SHADE)

Rich, densely branching foliage forms a perfect globular shape. Requires trimming to maintain form.

**EMERALD SPREADER (MONLOO) YEW**  
*Taxus cuspidata 'Monloo'*  
Zone: 5 Height: 80 cm  
Spread: 3 m  
Shape: Branching  
Foliage: Deep green  
Fruit: Red berry  
(SUN, PS)

A low maintenance spreader suitable for ground cover, embankment plantings or low hedges. Slow growing with a flat-topped form.

**DWARF YEW**  
*Taxus cuspidata 'Nana'*  
Zone: 4 Height: 1 m  
Spread: 1 m  
Shape: Spreading  
Fruit: Red berry  
Foliage: Dark green  
(SUN or SHADE)

Hardy, dwarf and slow growing. A handsome evergreen that is useful in any landscape.

**DENSE YEW**  
*Taxus x media 'Densiformis'*  
Zone: 5 Height: 1.2 m  
Spread: 2 m  
Shape: Rounded  
Fruit: Red berry  
Foliage: Dark green  
(SUN or SHADE)

A broad, compact, slow growing variety. Shade tolerant.

**SUNBURST YEW**  
*Taxus x media 'Sunburst'*  
Zone: 5 Height: 2 m  
Spread: 3 m  
Shape: Spreading  
Foliage: Golden-yellow  
(SUN)

An attractive yew with yellow foliage that fades to green over the winter. Plant in full sun to retain colour.

## CEDAR

**EMERALD CEDAR**  
*Thuja occidentalis 'Emerald'*  
Zone: 4 Height: 4 m  
Spread: 1 m  
Shape: Narrow, pyramidal  
Fruit: Cones  
Foliage: Emerald green  
(SUN, PS)

A bright green, dense pyramid that was introduced from Sweden.

**GOLDEN GLOBE CEDAR**  
*Thuja occidentalis 'Golden Globe'*  
Zone: 3 Height: 1 m  
Spread: 1 m  
Shape: Globe  
Foliage: Gold-yellow (SUN)

A showy cedar with bright golden foliage. Needs full sun to retain its bright colour.

**HOLMSTRUP CEDAR**  
*Thuja occidentalis 'Holmstrup'*  
Zone: 3 Height: 2.5 m  
Spread: 1 m  
Shape: Pyramidal  
Fruit: Cones (SUN, PS)  
Foliage: Apple green

Compact with bright green colour. Slow growing.

## LITTLE GIANT GLOBE CEDAR

*Thuja occidentalis* 'Little Giant'

Zone: 3 Height: 1 m  
Spread: 1 m  
Shape: Globe (SUN, PS)  
Foliage: Dark green

Vivid foliage and a rounded form characterize this compact and hardy plant.

## GLOBE CEDAR

*Thuja occidentalis* 'Woodwardii'

Zone: 3 Height: 1.25 m  
Spread: 1.25 m  
Shape: Rounded  
Fruit: Cones  
Foliage: Dark green (SUN)

Bushy and compact, great for use in foundation or border plantings.

## YELLOW RIBBON CEDAR

*Thuja occidentalis* 'Yellow Ribbon'

Zone: 4 Height: 2 m  
Spread: 1 m  
Shape: Pyramidal (SUN)  
Foliage: Golden-yellow

Very dense, semi-dwarf cedar which retains its bright colour throughout the year.

## HEMLOCK

### CANADIAN HEMLOCK

*Native*

*Tsuga canadensis*

Zone: 4 Height: 18 m  
Spread: 5 m  
Shape: Pyramidal  
Fruit: Cones  
Foliage: Dark glossy green (SUN or SHADE)

Graceful habit, slow growing.

### JEDDELOH DWARF HEMLOCK

*Tsuga canadensis* 'Jeddeloh'

Zone: 4 Height: 1.5 m  
Spread: 1.5 m  
Shape: Mounded  
Fruit: Cones  
Foliage: Bright green (SUN or SHADE)

## **BROADLEAF EVERGREENS**

### BOG ROSEMARY

*Andromeda polifolia*

'Blue Ice'

Zone: 3 Height: 30 cm  
Spread: 1 m  
Shape: Mounding  
Flower: Pink  
Foliage: Gray-green  
Fall Colour: Green with a tinge of purple (SUN, PS)

Very low growing evergreen shrub with gray-green foliage and delicate spring blooms.

### VANCOUVER JADE BEARBERRY

*Arctostaphylos uva-ursi*

Zone: 1 Height: 15 cm  
Spread: 1 m  
Shape: Low, spreading  
Flower: Pink  
Fruit: Scarlet-red  
Fall Colour: Brilliant crimson (SUN, PS)

Makes an excellent ground cover. The leaves turn a brilliant crimson in later winter. Use in dry locations.

### GREEN GEM BOXWOOD

*Buxus mic. var. insularis*

A fine processing plum when properly mature. Self-fruitful, prolific tree. A bluish-purple, small fruit.

**Italian Prune**

This extremely popular variety of medium-sized Blue plum is outstanding for canning or storage. The fruit ripens in late September.

**Mount Royal**

This juicy Blue plum originated near Montreal and is very hardy. The fruit are medium sized with rich Yellow flesh. Fruit can be picked in late August.

**Redheart**

Zone 5. A Japanese plum with dark red fruit and red flesh. Late August. Requires *Santa Rosa* or other Japanese variety for pollination.

**Santa Rosa**

A Japanese variety producing large, oval-shaped fruit with purplish-red skin. Firm yellow flesh turns red as it nears the skin. Mid-July. Self fruiting.

**Toka**

A very hardy plum for northern climates. Medium sized, rich flavoured variety with a beautiful Apricot colour. Mid August ripening.

Red, medium acid with aromatic flavour. Suitable for canning, freezing and dessert. Early, mid July

**Killarney**

Fruit medium red, medium firm. Very hardy. Ripens mid season

**Annapolis**

Medium-red, glossy berries that appear early in the season. Very good, medium-sized fruit production. Winter hardy.
